

Oxbridge Programme

The Oxbridge Programme at d'Overbroeck's is part of the wider 'Supercurricular' academic enrichment programme, a unique and specially developed programme to help Sixth Form students to explore their academic interests in greater depth alongside their regular studies.

Our academic enrichment activities equip students for their next steps in education or working life through a challenging and stimulating range of opportunities that students can select based on their ambitions. This particular enrichment programme is designed for students who want to apply to Oxford or Cambridge.

Students on the programme receive:

- Advice preparation for a competitive application
- Access to a subject guide for every course at Oxford and Cambridge giving a suggested timeline for preparation from the start of Year 12
- Access to a teacher who will oversee, support and mentor the applicant
- Access to an up-to-date list of all competitions aimed at Sixth Form students in all subject areas
- Access to an up-to-date list highlighting opportunities at Oxford and Cambridge
- Access to a wealth of resources on Oxford and Cambridge
- Guidance on selecting universities and courses
- The opportunity to attend a school organised meeting with guest speakers including a current admissions tutor and current Oxford students who are alumni of d'Overbroeck's.
- The opportunity to take a mock admissions exam in Year 12 with feedback
- Support for pre-interview admissions assessments
- Help with personal statements
- Mock interviews and feedback
- Continued support for gap year students
